Please join us at a public meeting sponsored by San Joaquin County Mental Health Services to talk about planning for San Joaquin County's MHSA Housing Program.

In November 2004, voters passed Proposition 63, the Mental Health Services Act, which will transform mental health care for children, youth, adults and seniors. The Mental Health Services Act Housing Program (MHSA HP) component of the Act was signed into law in May 2006 with the intended goal of creating 10,000 additional units statewide. The MHSA HP provides funding for the capital costs and operating subsidies to develop permanent supportive housing for persons with serious mental illness who are homeless, or at risk of homelessness, and who meet the MHSA Housing Program target population criteria.
