## **DO I QUALIFY FOR MEDI-CAL?**

As part of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, the income requirements for Medi-Cal eligibility have been increased, meaning more people will now qualify. The income limits are based on household size and the Federal Poverty Level (FPL), a figure calculated by the U.S. government every year. If your are between 19-64 years of age and :

**An Individual**

earning up to

**\$16,243 annually**

**A Household of Four**

earning up to

**\$33,465 annually**
