Interventions will be most effective when they address and include all levels of the socio-ecological model (SEM).

7 Elements of Suicide Care

- Lead: Create a leadership-driven, safety-oriented culture committed to dramatically reducing suicide among people under our care
- Train: Develop a competent, confident, and caring workforce
- o Identify: Systematically identify and assess suicide risk among people receiving care
- Engage: Ensure every individual has a pathway to care
- o Treat: Use effective, EB treatments that directly target suicidal thoughts and behaviors
- o Transition: Provide continuous support especially after acute care
- Improve: Apply data-driven, quality improvement approach
