#### **MHS Grievances**

The QAPI office received a total of 63 Legal grievances and 36 Non – Legal Grievances for the Fiscal year 22-23. For the FY22-23, there were three (3) grievances related to Access to Care, thirty – one (31) Quality of Care, four (4) Related to Customer Service, eight (8) Related to Case Manager and Seventeen (17) Filed for Other Reason. The grievances were resolve at 87% timely.

#### **SUD Grievances**

The QAPI office received a total of twelve (12) Legal grievances and seven (7) Non – Legal Grievances for the Fiscal year 22-23. For the FY22-23, there were six (6) grievances related to Access to Care, two (2) Related to Customer Service and four (4) Filed for Other Reason. The grievances were resolve 83% timely.

October 2023 Legislative Report – Gertie Kandris

If Proposition 1 is passed, it will create housing settings for 11,000 unhoused Californians, many of them Veterans, with severest mental health needs experiencing homelessness, substance use and mental health issues.

Proposition 1 will provide \$1Billion to ensure that our Veterans who are experiencing homelessness, mental health and substance use issues receive the care and housing they need to recover and stabilize.
